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2006 Star Lane Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc Santa Ynez Valley – 88 points

(\$20) Light, bright yellow. Grassy citrus and apple aromas are complicated by floral, minty and smoky mineral notes. Shows sweeter peach and melon on the palate, with a tangy mineral bite on the back. Continued to gain in sweetness with air, finishing with good breadth and persistence. I'd serve this with a spicy Asian seafood or chicken dish.
