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### Vintage

2021 presented unique challenges specific to Star Lane that we didn't see in the Sta. Rita Hills. Frost events at the end of 2020 before the vines went dormant impacted early Spring growth in 2021. This led to uneven bud break timing, shoot growth, and flowering. While challenging, we've learned over the years of farming that grapevines are very resilient and that great wine is not made but discovered. The craft is to embrace the discovery of each vintage. 2021 was no exception to this rule. We had to remove fruit from short shoots, saw dramatic reduction in yields, but had near perfect weather all year and observed intense flavors, and terrific tannin development that created very structured wines. 2021 has notions of both 2019's fresh structure and 2020's intense forward fruit. The blend is Cabernet Sauvignon 82%; Cab Franc 6%; Petite Verdot 6%; Merlot 5%, Malbec 1%

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### WINEMAKER NOTES

2021 gave us fruit with natural energy and balance, allowing the vineyard to speak with uncommon purity. The result is a Cabernet Sauvignon defined by freshness, fine structure, and transparency rather than power alone. The 2021 vintage highlights the inherent class of this single vineyard site: pushing pure blue fruits like blueberry alongside characteristic sage and floral notes, all built on a precise mouthfeel structured to deliver for a long time.
